



How do I find a job in Malta?

You can start your job search in Malta, by visiting the site of the Public Employment Service (www.jobsplus.gov.mt). As an EU national you can register for a free account (even whilst still living abroad) and upload your CV online. To register for an account, go to this [link](#).

You can also choose to receive a daily email with all the new vacancies.

Besides, you can check personally with private recruitment agencies in Malta. The official list of registered private recruitment agencies in Malta can be found [here](#). Besides you may refer to social media and newspapers in order to view vacancies.

Where can I find information about Living and Working in Malta?

What should I do before I leave my country?

You are required to inform the **Taxation Department** that you will be leaving and where you are moving to. Besides, it is advisable to contact the **Department of Social Security** in order to obtain a statement of contributions.

It is recommended that you can also speak to **EURES advisers in your country** to find out more about what you should do before you leave. You can find a list of advisers on the [EURES portal](#).

It is important that you have a valid **European Health Card**.

It might also be a good idea to get the **recognition of any academic and vocational qualifications**. The process is completed online via **ENIC NARIC** Network. You can either contact the institution in the country you obtained the qualification from or the one in Malta.
